Treasurer's Report

Net funding of \$17k, thanks to \$42k from the library fair. December and year-end donations will be critical. Pension items are not noted but will appear in October's report.

Moved the \$23.604.13 out of the Operating into Vanguard for the two employee pensions, that will show on the October statement

Director's Report

An exterminator will start coming monthly.

HVAC for the staff zone - applied for a grant through NYSLibrary Construction grants. A lot of hurdles but so far we were granted 50% (\$3,122).

Hiring D'Amico Electric to look at the fluorescent bulbs to see what needs to be replaced.

Staffing has been very challenging, lots of people have been sick. Under NYS law, part-timers are given 1 hour of paid sick leave for every 30 hours that they work

WLS IT Service Level Agreement needs to be renewed, Cindy sent it around for review. We've decided to migrate our email accounts to save money. Total of \$41,166.26 agreement. Motion to Approve: George, Seconded: Lisa, Approved Unanimously.
